## TRANSCRIPT OF GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE MEETINGS HELD ON JUNE 11, 2020

Linda Manley, Senior Vice President and Counsel to the Agencies, stated that she will now open the June 11, 2020 meeting of the Governance Committee of the New York State Housing Finance Agency, the State of New York Mortgage Agency, the Affordable Housing Corporation, the State of New York Municipal Bond Bank Agency and the Tobacco Settlement Financing Corporation and noted that because of the novel corona virus emergency in the State, and Federal bans on large meetings or gathering and pursuant to Governor Cuomo's executive order 220.1 issued on March 12, 2020, which order was extended on April 9, 2020 certain provision of the open meetings law have been suspended.

Ms. Manley also stated that the Board meeting would be held by conference call instead of as a public meeting open for the public to attend in person, and that a call-in number was made public for the public to listen to the proceedings.

Ms. Manley noted that because of these special features a change in voting procedures would be put in place for this meeting and she would be asking each Board member to record their votes individually.

Ms. Manley asked for a motion to call the meeting of the SONYMA Governance Committee to order. Chairman Adams made the motion and Mr. Kapell seconded. Mr. Ballan voted aye, Ms. Vullo voted aye; Ms. Visnauskas voted aye, Mr. Olczak voted aye; and Ms. Gonzalez voted aye. Ms. Manley noted the presence of a quorum for SONYMA.
