### LOW-INCOME HOUSING TAX CREDIT PROGRAM COMMISSIONER DETERMINATION

Project Name: Golden Ridge IV – SHARS 20186014

Project Applicant/Awardee: Access: Supports for Living, Inc.

Pursuant to Section 2040.3(g)(5) of the New York State Division of Housing and Community Renewal's Low-Income Housing Credit Qualified Allocation Plan (QAP), the Division reserves the right to allocate Low-Income Housing Tax Credit to implement such special priorities contained in a Notice of Credit Availability or Request for Proposals and to advance coordinated investments by State, federal, and local government partners. Furthermore, the Division is authorized to allocate Low-Income Housing Tax Credit to projects irrespective of their point ranking, if such allocation is in furtherance of the State's housing goals and is determined by the Commissioner of the Division to be in the interests of the citizens of the State of New York.

The project has been deemed eligible for financing based on a finding that the project advances the State housing goals, coordinated investments and/or special housing priorities described below:

- The project advances the Empire State Supportive Housing Initiative (ESSHI) by targeting 17 units to households with special needs who will receive services and supports through the Initiative.
- The project represents a coordinated investment with other State government financing partners, including the New York State Office for Persons with Developmental Disabilities and the New York State Office of Mental Health.

Based on the information noted above and the Division's review of the project application, a Determination has been made that the award and intended allocation of Low-Income Housing Tax Credit for this project is consistent with the above-referenced QAP standards.
