### **CONSTRUCTION PROJECT MANAGER**

We have offices in New York City, Albany, Buffalo and Syracuse, and employ a diverse workforce of professionals who are hard-working and committed to serving low and moderate income families. Our mission is far reaching, encompassing single and multifamily housing finance, home improvement, rent regulation, housing subsidies, and community development. We partner regularly with a variety of public and private stakeholders.

Achieving this mission requires a wide range of skills and backgrounds in public policy, administration, real estate, architecture, finance, law and many other areas of expertise. We seek to provide a workplace environment that is productive, flexible, accountable, ethical and caring. Our employees are empowered to make a difference where they live and work. We offer competitive pay and a comprehensive benefits package, including paid leave, health, dental, vision, retirement, and family-friendly policies.

**The Office of Finance & Development** manages **HCR's** multifamily and single-family housing programs and bond offerings. HCR has been the most active housing bond issuer in the country in 4 of the last five years, issuing approximately \$13 billion in tax exempt and taxable housing bonds to fund initiatives ranging in scope from mixed income rental developments to single family mortgages. Finance & Development actively engages with a range of partners including for-profit, and not for profit borrowers, municipalities, lenders, investors and other funding entities to leverage Low Income Housing Tax Credits, tax exempt bonds, single family lending programs, and a multitude of State funded programs. Our resources have helped finance over 42,000 affordable apartments and affordable homes since 2011. Finance & Development has primary responsibility for implementing many of the initiatives under the Governor's new House NY 2020 plan, an unprecedented \$20 billion investment over the next five years.

#### **DUTIES (under direct and limited supervision):**

- Ability to inspect, evaluate, and priority rate and/or review consultant recommendations of deteriorated physical conditions of varied types of residential buildings, ranging from single family homes, to low-rise garden apartment complexes through high-rise apartment houses of all types of construction methodology.
- Ability to review, evaluate and report on the feasibility of new construction projects of all construction methodologies for low rise and hi rise housing.



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- Oversee, monitor and report on the progress of work of multiple Agency funded construction projects for the purposes of ensuring adherence to contract documents and the completion of industry quality work for the sign-off of monthly requisitions submitted to the Agency Loan Servicing Unit
- Coordinate all funding applications for CES review from other Agency units to ensure that all of the required information for both construction items and environmental requirements has been submitted and that the unit protocol for review has not been compromised.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Working knowledge of the architectural and/or construction industry based on past trade experience working in a similar or related capacity and/or as a contractor or sub-contractor. An AAS Degree or Accredited Certificate in Construction Management from a certified trade school or NYS Certification as a Building Codes Official may be substituted.
- Fully trained and able to use a PC, including MS Office, Outlook, Word and Excel, and full written and oral presentation and reporting skills. Demonstrated administrative skills for records management and the ability to professionally represent the Agency in the field and office.
- Willing to travel locally and upstate at Agency and own expense with expeditious applicable reimbursements.
