DUTIES

Assist program directors in developing and implementing special programs by:

- Preparing competitive solicitations to onboard program administrators, including notices of funding availability (NOFAs) and Requests for Proposals (RFPs).
- Managing agency projects by conducting research, developing implementation strategies, providing oversight, implementing policies and procedures, and offering recommendations to program staff to resolve issues and ensure project timelines are met.
- Performing research and analysis for the assigned program area; and prepare reports for use by management.
- Maintaining partnerships with internal and external entities. Meet with outside stakeholders to discuss program and projects.
- Identifying barriers to the success of projects and propose and implement solutions.
