Q1. Is more information about the parcel sizes, locations and required setbacks available?

Q2. Is 100 or 200 amp utility service required for the units?

A2. 200 amp service is required. The budget table has been updated to specify.

Q3. Are the proposals based on a slab or crawlspace foundation?

Q3. The budget table has been updated to request average pricing for both types of foundations.

Q4. If one lot will be selected in each of the identified communities, who will choose the lot?

A4. The final design, site preparation and install will be a coordinated effort with the Land Banks representing each area. Ultimately the Land Bank will choose the preferred site considering feasibility in consultation with the home producer.
